Theatre Arts

The Associate of Arts degree in Theater is intended to provide students with the courses that focus on a strong foundation in the creative, technical and historical aspects of the theater arts.

Requirements for the Associate of Arts (A.A.) Degree

- 1. Credit for at least 60 semester hours of college work, excluding developmental courses.
- a. Fulfillment of the 42-hour core curriculum as part of the

60-hour total

b. At least 25 percent of semseter hours must be earned in

college-level courses through McLennan.

- 2. An overall grade point average of at least 2.0
- 3. Successful completion of the college's Developmental Education Plan for the Texas Success Initiative.
- 4. Payment of all financial obligations to the college.
